10 Responsibilities of the Board

- ❖ 1) Determine the Mission and Purpose and advocate for them
- ❖ 2) Select the Chief Executive
- ❖ 3) Support the Chief Executive and assess their performance
- ❖ 4) Ensure Effective Organizational Planning
- ❖ 5) Manage Financial Resources Effectively



10 Responsibilities of the Board

- ❖ 6) Monitor and Strengthen Programs and Services
- ❖ 7) Protect Assets and Provide Financial Oversight
- ❖ 8) Enhance the Organizations Public Image
- ❖ 9) Ensure Legal and Ethical Integrity and Maintain Accountability
- ❖ 10) Recruit and Orient New Board Members



Time Commitment



- 3 in person meetings annually (Winter, Summer, Fall)
- Monthly Board Call which can last up to 2 hours
- Monthly committee call
- Attend at minimum two AACCS events



Financial Commitment

- Cost will vary from board member to board member it is important that all board members understand that serving on the board requires a certain financial commitment



Financial Commitment

- Board members are responsible for covering all personal costs associated with attending board meetings and events. This includes flights, lodging, ground transportation and meals. Cost can exceed \$7,500
